## FEMALE PARTICIPATION ACROSS HIGHER EDUCATION LEVELS

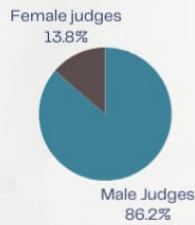
Women's participation declines sharply beyond the undergraduate level, with very limited representation at advanced research stages.



## WOMEN PARTICIPATION IN 18TH LOK SABHA, 2024

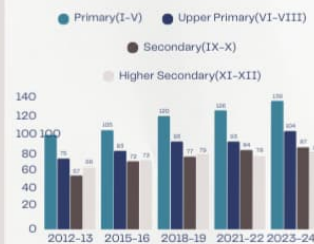

## Women Teachers Across School Education Levels (per 100 male teachers)

Women teachers are strongly represented at primary levels, but their presence steadily declines at higher stages of schooling.
